A Plan for St Paul's Knightsbridge that tackles the big question asked daily and hourly by everyone.



**The big question asked daily and hourly by theatres, museums, churches, professional developers, retailers, councils spending billions on regeneration, high streets, employers and ourselves at home: how do we create a place that we want to be?**

Commercial questions around footfall, keeping people on site, return visits and related spending, and more generally fulfilling our needs for enjoyment and wellbeing are central to the value of answering this question well.

Going beyond use functions, the spiritual aspect of a beautiful space is something we often immediately understand, yet rarely articulate. With new proposed facilities including music rooms, small and large meeting rooms and support spaces see how it can be done in C21st with the historic, grade 2 listed St Paul's Church Knightsbridge.
