The low energy house was inspired by the West Country's diffuse and piercing light. Designed for clients in their Third Age, Beeches is an architectural solution that addresses modern life, longevity, landscape and climate with a private and generous architecture. When existing homes for the elderly or retired can often be drab and dreary, Beeches is a model for future Third Age living and it shows how a beautiful home doesn't have to cost the earth.

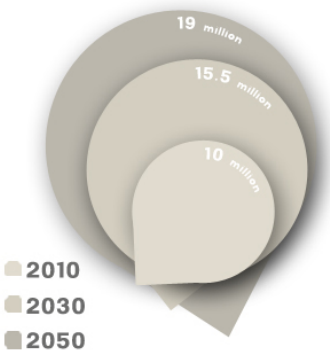
"10 million people in the UK are over 65 years old. The latest projections are for 5.5 million more elderly people in 20 years time and the number will have nearly doubled to around 19 million by 2050." (1)

By 2031, The London Plan estimates the number of people over 65 years old will grow by 34%, reaching 1.17 million. The overall population of London by 2031 is expected to be 8.82 million (7.80 million in 2011). (2)
